<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Follows instructions at a 4 word level containing nouns, verbs, & prepositions Understands more complex prepositions such as :- behind in front of in between Understands comparisons, e.g. <i>bigger, smaller, taller, faster</i> Understands the pronouns - he she Groups items according to named category e.g. <i>animals</i> Responds to questions about stories, events, or experiences e.g. <i>what did you do in P.E.? Where has the boy gone?</i> Follows a simple story or news event including detail from past, present and future Beginning to understand implied information Understands use of regular tenses, past, present and future e.g. <i>washed</i> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Actively listens and attends to a story for a short period of time in a group situation e.g. <i>shows by body movement or facial expression that they are attending to what is being said</i> Responds by looking at speaker Offering comments Take turns in discussion, listening to others Occupies self on self chosen activity for 15 or more minutes Concentrates with an adult for 10 minutes on directed activities 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Selects play activity using previous experience and preference Plans a sequence of pretend events Organises other children and resources needed for an activity Play with others, looking towards them as they speak and responding appropriately by undertaking a simple request.. Take on the persona of a familiar character in role play or drama Listens to & responds appropriately in role play Can combine more than one event in role play Highly imaginative play Sets scene without realistic props
