<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pupils make spontaneous decisions when all solutions are correct <i>e.g. sit down in the circle, choose a colour</i>..... • Pupils begin to make decisions based on preferred options when given 2 choices <i>e.g. blackcurrant or orange, big sweet or small sweet</i>..... • Pupils consistently make decisions based on preferred options in everyday real life settings when given 2 choices <i>e.g. choosing their pudding from a choice of 2 on view at the hatch</i>..... • Pupils begin to notice when something is "wrong" or "different" as part of familiar routines or actions <i>e.g. no drink in a cup</i>..... • Pupils demonstrate an ability to cope by being calm and not showing signs of distress when they notice something is "wrong" or "different" as part of a familiar routine • Pupils notice something is "wrong" or "different" during a familiar routine or action and attempt to communicate about the problem in some way..... • Pupils will watch and attempt to imitate an adult in order to solve a problem during a familiar activity or routine <i>e.g. look for a missing puzzle piece under a table/out of view</i>..... • Pupil recognises and begins to try to solve simple problems for themselves before asking for help <i>e.g. no chair to sit on in the circle, so looks around the classroom for one</i>..... 	<div style="border: 1px solid black; width: 30px; height: 30px; display: flex; align-items: center; justify-content: center; margin: 0 auto;">8</div>
